

Urine Collection tips for cats:

Use a non absorbable litter that we can provide for you.

Wash and dry litter pan thoroughly.

Replace litter with non absorbable litter.

After cat uses litter box, pour urine and litter back into sterile cup provided or a very clean jar.

Close lid tightly. ©

Return sample to hospital as soon as possible.

If you can't get here right away, refrigerate or put on ice.

Urine sample cannot be older than four hours.

Urine Collection tips for dogs:

Find a shallow clean pan or tray such as a small pie plate. (We can provide you with a plastic tray.)

Take your dog outside on a leash.

When he or she goes to squat or lift their leg – sneak the tray under them to catch the urine.

Pour urine into a very clean jar.

Close lid tightly. ©

Return sample to hospital as soon as possible.

If you can't get here right away, refrigerate or put on ice.

Urine sample cannot be older than four hours.
